RANDOM ACTS OF KINDNESS AT RB

The SCSC donated Legos and accessories to the RB Library as part of the Random Acts of Kindness Program: Below is an letter from Heather H. one of our RB residents, moms, story-time leader, and Lego Club Coach.

The first week we had about 45 kids and parents. Over the next several sessions we have had around 60, with Mr. Sherman unable to get an accurate count because of so many moving bodies. It has been awesome.

The kids benefit from mixed age open play. Generally, they can build anything they want to. I have to limit the number of baseplates per person simply because there are so many kids. But kids often work together and will negotiate combining of their assets, as it were, to achieve their building goal. So a team may build a multi level structure by utilizing all their baseplates.

But more recently I have been giving them a building challenge, and they can choose to accept the challenge or not. It gets them out of their comfort zone and helps them to think differently. The first challenge was to build the tallest most stable structure you could out of 25 pieces. This is great for spatial thinking and reasoning.

My favorite thing about Lego Club is that it is LOUD. Everyone is busy and engaged, but using a very different part of their brain. This engagement is social and free, allowing them to create their own rules and build their own ideas. I walk around and only have to encourage here and there, and always praise the process rather than the result. They are then able to name and label their creation and display it in the library. They are often very proud.

This gives us so much as a community. Kids are engaged and happy, making their own fun. Parents have the opportunity to talk to one another, and meet new people or solidify relationships. I even have several volunteers, young people that come and engage with the kids, help set up and clean up, and assist kids when needed.

This one gift has engaged all levels of our community, and is a wonderful addition to our offerings at the library. Thank you for your act of kindness!
